



GOLF SOCIETY VISITOR INFORMATION

We hope you have a wonderful experience at Corhampton; you are very welcome at our Club.

Please find some useful information below regarding your visit - do not hesitate to contact our staff if you require any assistance. Payments are by debit/credit card only – no cash.

Mobile phones

Please feel free to make calls in the car park. Phones should only be used on the course for medical emergencies.

On the Course

Conventional golf wear is required.

Hats, caps and visors should be removed when in the clubhouse. If caps or hats with peaks are worn whilst on the course, peaks must face forward.

Denim, cargo shorts or cargo trousers and trainers are not permitted.

Gentlemen

Collared shirts should be tucked in. Trousers and shorts should be tailored, and can be worn with long socks or white sports socks.

Ladies

Ladies may wear tailored trousers, cut-offs, shorts, skorts or skirts of appropriate length.

In the clubhouse

Smart clothing is required. If having played in inclement weather do not wear dirty/wet clothing or footwear into the clubhouse bar or Hartwell Room.

Pace of play

Ideally, 18 holes will take no more than four hours. 'Ready golf' is the preferred method of play.

Golf Etiquette

For other golfer's enjoyment, please rake bunker's and replace your own divot; repair ball marks and prepare to putt whilst others are playing their ball. If you reach your maximum allowable score, we suggest you pick up!

Course Marshal

If the Course Marshal has reason to speak to you, please comply with the instructions respectfully. They are there to ensure that all players enjoy the course.

Please remember that any restrictions that are put on the course at short notice are put there for a good reason either for the safety of other players or for the benefit of keeping the course in the best conditions possible and should be respected and adhered to by all players.
