Golf Course Spectator Guidance

Thank you for supporting today's players.

Golf is a self-regulating sport that relies upon concentration, fairness and good etiquette.

Please help us by following the guidance below.

Please Do

- ✓ Stay well clear of players and the line of play.
- ✓ Remain behind players whenever possible.
- ✓ Stay on paths, or preferably in the safer recommended viewing areas listed below.
- ✓ Remain silent whilst shots are being played.
- ✓ Follow any instructions given by officials or Course Marshals.
- ✓ Be aware that golf balls travel significant distances and not always in the intended direction.

Please Do Not

- ✗ Walk on tees, greens, approaches or fairways.
- ✗ Stand between holes or in landing areas.
- ✗ Give advice or coaching to players.
- ✗ Carry clubs or assist players during play.
- ✗ Use mobile phones in a manner that may distract players.
- ✗ Interfere with play in any way.

Important Safety Notice

It is customary for a golfer to shout "fore" if their ball is heading off course. If you hear this shout then please protect yourself accordingly. There can, however, be no guarantee that a shout of "fore" may be given or heard, so it is important to follow the guidance provided and remain vigilant at all times.

Golf balls can travel at high speed and players occasionally hit shots in unintended directions. For this reason, spectators attend at their own risk and are responsible for maintaining a safe position and remaining alert at all times.

Recommended Viewing Areas

Where appropriate, spectators are encouraged to view play from:

- The Clubhouse Balcony
- Spooners Halfway House
- The Wayfarer's Walk Public Right of Way
- Other locations designated by event organisers
