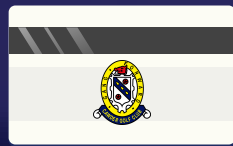

COMPETITIONS

- Competitions are played on both courses with classes rotating between courses. The BRS system indicates what course for each week
- Wednesday medals are played weekly on the Keir course
- The Fixtures are available on the BRS app and your members Club diary
- So download the BRS Golf app to make entering competitions easy
- Times for competitions are released at 7pm 9 days in advance of the competition
- Matchplay events entries can be made via the Club V1 Members app. Entries close the 2nd week in March.
- On competition day please sign-in at the pro-shop and after the round enter your score on the Club competitor up-stairs in the clubhouse.

And please remember to post your card after entering your score in the Club computer





MEMBERSHIP CARD

Your member's card provides access to the clubhouse via the secure entry on the doors. Your card also holds your funds that are loaded onto your card, which you can top at the bar. **Please note:** you need to use your card to benefit from discounted food and drink in the bar.

LOCKERS

We offer three types of locker: Jumbo - £45/year, Standard - £35/year and Holdall - £15/year. The Office will be able to advise if any are available and if not your name will be placed on a waiting list until one becomes available.



CADDY SHED

The caddy shed is for trolleys and there is no cost. Members are just required to secure their trolley to one of the side/roof bars. Equipment stored in this area is at members' own risk and the club does not accept responsibility for loss or damage.

BOOKINGS

This service allows members to book tee times online or via the BRS Golf app, providing instant on-screen and email confirmation of the booking.

This booking service provides an accurate and up to date picture of tee availability.

REGISTER

To register simply go to www.brsgolf.com/cawder/members_home.php and click register. Note: you will require your membership number, included on your invoice receipt.

The webpage also provides instructions on how to use the BRS system.

RULES

Each member can only book one tee time per day.

You can book Mon-Sun up to 8 days in advance. Times for competitions are released at 7pm 9 days in advance.

Please remember to delete bookings if you no longer require them.

CODE OF CONDUCT

At Cawder we have a simple Code of Conduct: respect your golf course, your fellow golfers and members of staff.

DRESS CODE

We operate a relaxed dress code throughout the Club. Jeans (no holes/tears) and trainers are allowed in the clubhouse but not on the course. Football colours are not permitted on the course or in the clubhouse. Tailored shorts and turtle neck shirts are permitted on the course and in the clubhouse. All other shirts must have a collar.

MOBILE PHONES

The club would prefer no calls are made or received in the main lounges, but phones can be used if on silent. Calls can however be made or received within the hallways or locker room area. Free Wi-fi access is available in the main lounges, so please feel free to share your positive experiences on social media. 👍

- Repair all pitch marks
- Rake the bunkers
- Please put all litter in bins provided

WINTER GOLF

In the winter, we ask members to play from mats to protect the course, so that its ready earlier in the season. The mats usually commence when the clocks change in the last weekend in October and continue through to mid March, weather permitting. Winter mats can be purchased from the Pro Shop.

We also ask that trolleys use winter wheels during this period.
