FAQs

What if I do not have a smartphone or cannot log into the Howdidido App?

Players can sign in and enter their scores via the score entry computer in the clubhouse.

What if the Howdidido App crashes or fails mid-round?

Players should enter their scores via the score entry computer in the clubhouse if they cannot do so via the app.

Having one player be the marker to fill out a scorecard among the group will enable score verification if the app or score entry machine fails.

Will I have my own scorecard for competitions?

Each member may take a blank scorecard to record their own scores if they wish, however one person among a group should be the official marker for that group and submit a scorecard for that group.

What are the procedures for flagsticks, bunkers and holing the ball in light of Covid-19?

How should I withdraw from a competition if I need to?

Members can withdraw themselves out of a competition via BRS in the normal way.

For weekend board competitions, the time sheet is locked 3 days in advance and anyone withdrawing from this point onwards should email teetimes@fulwellgolfclub.co.uk If a member withdraws less than 24 hours before the start of a weekend board competition, unfortunately the competition entry fee would still be charged.
