



Reopening the Clubhouse with inside seating – Covid 19

The below outlines how Fulwell Golf Club will operate for the reopening of inside seating from Monday 17th August. Our measures and procedures are under constant review, updated as advice from Government, health authorities and governing bodies evolves in line with the gradual lifting of social restrictions.

How will we operate in the clubhouse?

- Seating to be available in the long bar and middle dining room (when required)
- Tables of 2 only with 3 tables of 4 available for members from only 2 households
- Tables and chairs are not to be moved by golfers
- Members will be allocated a table by a staff member and asked to sanitise on arrival
- A maximum of 40 golfers in the long bar and middle dining room will be permitted. If maximum is reached, those who have been in the longest will be asked to make way for new arrivals
- Table service only and golfers must not use the bar to order drinks
- Serving staff will be wearing protective masks/shield
- One-way system in operation (please follow arrows on the floor)
 - Entry to the indoor seating is via the spike bar and turn right where you will be seated by a staff member
 - Exit through the middle dining room and down the hallway through the main doors
- If you are using the toilet, please follow the one way system and re-enter via the one way system
- Payment will be via member card (give your name to the staff member) or via contactless card payment (up to £45)
- Please top up remotely, club v1 members app or howdoipay.
- All tables and chairs to be sanitised following use
- All surfaces to be regularly sanitised
- All doors to be wedged open

Please note – Staff have the authority to refuse service if the above is not followed
