Procedures for Bad Weather and Suspensions of Play

Immediate Stop – One prolonged note of the siren (typically for the threat of lightning)

Mark ball (The golf ball may be lifted, see rule 14.1 page 76), cease play and take shelter.

Normal Stop – Three consecutive notes of the siren (typically for lack of light or course declared unplayable through water or wind).

If between holes, cease play and do not make another stroke until “Resume Play” signal is given.

If playing a hole, players may continue to finish but must not make another stroke on the next tee.

Resume Play – Two short notes of the siren.

Competition Conditions:

A player must resume play from where he or she stopped play on a hole or, if between holes, at the next teeing area, even if play is resumed on a different day.

The player must replace the original ball or another ball on the original spot (which if not known must be estimated, see rule 14.2 page 77)
