Texas “Shamble” Rules, Saturday 28th March 2026 YELLOW/RED TEES

Please find your card on the PSI desk, no sign in required.

A “shamble” is a golf competition that mixes the texas scramble format with a better ball.

Please enter scores on PSI after play
Stableford – 85% of course handicap (see chart by PSI)

Scoring & Rules

- On every hole the best 2 scores will count for the team score
 - Par 3’s – Play your own ball for the entire hole
 - Par 4’s & 5’s – **Scramble** off the tee then play your own ball in (**minimum 3 drives per player**, 4 drives for teams of 3)
 - The player whose drive was selected should be first to play their second shot from that point, followed by the remaining team members
 - The card **MUST** be marked identifying the player whose drive was selected on each hole
- From fairway, bunkers and on the green, the ball is to be placed within 6 inches (no nearer the hole)
- From the first cut and rough, the ball is to be dropped within 1 club length (no nearer the hole)

NOTE the drop can be in a better cut of grass providing it remains within 1 club length of where the selected ball lay and not nearer the hole. Should this get a player onto the fairway the ball is in play after the drop and cannot be lifted, cleaned & placed)
