

# Burnham-on-Crouch Golf Club

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

To help us make your day run more smoothly we would be grateful if all players will observe the accepted standards of etiquette. Please make sure that everyone attending is aware of this.

1. Please check that the Booking Form is correctly completed and return it to the Club Manager at the above address as soon as possible to confirm your booking along with a **deposit of £10.00pp (non-refundable)**. All cheques made payable to "Burnham-on-Crouch Golf Club Ltd", BACS details: Sort Code 521030, Account Number 02733102, please put enter: GS and date of your date as a reference.  
eg; GS03..05.2025
2. **Final confirmation of numbers may be left until nearer the date but must be telephoned or emailed not less than 7 days before your visit. Thereafter, the booked number or the actual, if greater, must be paid for.**
3. Rounds will normally commence on the 1<sup>st</sup> tee and any closure will be for that tee. Burnham-on-Crouch Golf Club reserves the right to change this if necessary. The Pace of play for a four ball is 4 hours 15 mins. Please be aware that members are entitled to "filter in" on the 10<sup>th</sup> Tee should the first Tee become busy.
4. These notes form part of the booking agreement and it is the responsibility of the Society organiser to ensure all members of the party are aware of these conditions.
5. Prices are in accordance with the enclosed list for a minimum of 12 players (8 for winter package). All fees to be paid on the day.
6. Societies may play 3 or 4 ball matches only but should remember that slower groups MUST call others through if they have lost ground to the match in front as per Golf Etiquette. GOLF ETIQUETTE WILL BE ENFORCED BY COURSE MARSHALL/PROFESSIONALS. Divots must be replaced, bunkers raked and spike or pitch marks repaired. Rakes should be left in the bunkers after use.
7. Only wide wheel trolleys are permitted and should be kept well clear of aprons, tees and greens.
8. Please confirm with the Pro Shop which Tees you be playing off on the day. The tee-off times requested must be adhered to.
9. There is a spike bar where golf shoes may be worn but spikes are not permitted in the main lounge.
10. **Dress on the course must be appropriate to the game of golf. No blue Denim, Shirts must be tucked into trousers or shorts. Shorts may be worn on the course & in clubhouse but must be of the tailored variety, knee length. No ¾ length trousers or cargo/combat type trousers. Trousers must not be tucked in to socks & no ripped, torn or dirty clothing is permitted. No flipflops on the course or in the clubhouse. Ladies may wear sleeveless shirts with a collar or sleeved shirts without a collar.**  
**Please note "If in doubt ask before arriving" – our members have set and abide by these rules - all visitors are expected to do so as well. Failure to do so may unfortunately result in no admittance.**
11. Dress in the Clubhouse should be smart casual during the day and jacket and tie when sitting for an evening meal unless previously agreed with the management. Shirts must be tucked into trousers (or shorts).
12. Mobile Phones - Must not be used to make or receive calls in the Clubhouse or on the course. (They may be used on the course in genuine emergencies)
13. May be used a 'smart' device in the Clubhouse to access internet, camera etc.
14. Must be on silent at all times.
15. All Society Members are responsible for their personal property.
16. We have a reception area and Pro-Shop where you can book in and if required, purchase Balls, Tees, Course Planners and Refreshments.

# Health & Safety Notice

Notice to ALL who Play/Caddy/Walk Burnham on Crouch Golf Course.

*There is always a danger of being struck by a golf ball so please be AWARE of what is going on in your surroundings.*

YOU ARE EXPECTED TO SHOUT THE WORD “FORE” IF YOUR BALL IS GOING TOWARDS OTHER PLAYERS OR IS GOING TO AN AREA THAT YOU CANNOT CLEARLY SEE. (OVER OR BEHIND TREES ETC)

IF YOU HEAR THE WORD “FORE” BEING SHOUTED COVER YOUR HEAD WITH YOUR HANDS AND KEEP DOWN. DO NOT LOOK UP OR AROUND.

WHEN PLAYING GOLF ALWAYS ENSURE THE PLAYERS IN FRONT ARE FAR ENOUGH AHEAD THAT YOUR BALL CANNOT HIT THEM.

NEVER STAND IN FRONT OR TO THE SIDE OF SOMEONE HITTING A GOLF BALL. (Stand clear of their backswing and behind them)

WHEN PLAYING THE THIRD HOLE ON THIS COURSE DO NOT HIT YOUR TEE SHOT UNTIL YOU HAVE HEARD THE BELL SOUND. IF YOU INTEND DRIVING THE HOLE YOU MUST FIRST MAKE SURE THE GROUP IN FRONT HAVE FINISHED AND LEFT THE GREEN.

WHEN YOU HAVE CROSSED THE BRIDGE PLEASE RING THE BELL.

WHEN PLAYING THE SEVENTEENTH HOLE A PERISCOPE IS AVAILABLE ON THE TEE TO ENSURE THE FAIRWAY IS CLEAR. PLEASE USE IT. DO NOT DRIVE UNTIL YOU ARE SURE THE GAME IN FRONT ARE OUT OF RANGE.

FINALLY – YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR ACTIONS.

# BURNHAM ON CROUCH GOLF CLUB - DRESS CODE

The Club asks all Members and Visitors to respect this code.

The expectation is that everyone should wear suitable attire both on the Course and in the Clubhouse.

Clothing should be clean, intact and suitable for the Golf Club.

The Club Management will be monitoring this and have the responsibility to maintain the expected standard.

At the discretion of the Club Management, Visitors (and Members) that do not conform to the dress code may be refused admittance or restricted to the Spike Bar.

## On the Golf Course and Practice Ground:

- **General**
  - Smart clean conventional golf attire should be worn at all times on the course and the practice ground
  - Caps may be worn with the peak facing forward
- **Clothing**
  - Tops must be worn
  - Shirts must have a collar, and must be tucked into the waistband unless specifically designed otherwise
  - Sleeveless shirts with a collar, polos, turtlenecks and roll necks are permitted
  - Football or rugby style shirts are not permitted. Tops with large logos are not permitted.
  - Tailored shorts, skorts and golf dresses with socks may be worn on the course and in the clubhouse
  - Combat type, tied waist shorts or other casual shorts are not permitted
  - Denim clothing, track suits, shell suits or leggings are not permitted on the course. Trousers must not be tucked into socks.
  - Juniors under the age of 10 may wear tracksuit bottoms and sweatshirts on the practice ground.
- **Footwear**
  - Golfers must wear golf shoes on the golf course. Trainers may be worn on the practice ground.
  - Non-golfers (e.g. Spectators) may wear flat soled shoes or trainers on the course but are not permitted on the greens at any time.

## In the Club House and on the Balcony

- **Clothing**
  - Clean, dry and smart clothing must be worn at all times
  - No hats or caps to be worn in the Clubhouse.
  - Smart jeans may be worn unless specified differently for events. These must not be frayed, ripped or stone washed.
  - Waterproof clothing, caps and hats are not permitted in the clubhouse
  - Combat type, tied waist shorts or other casual shorts are not permitted
  - Tracksuits or shell suits are not permitted
  - Non-playing visitors under the age of 10 are not subject to the Clubhouse Dress Code
- **Footwear**
  - Appropriate footwear must be worn at all times
  - Trainers, sandals, loafers and deck shoes are permitted with or without socks
  - No flip flops
  - No golf shoes in the lounge (permitted only in the changing rooms and spike bar)

## Mobile Phones

- Must not be used to make or receive calls in the Clubhouse or on the course. (They may be used on the course in genuine emergencies and by authorised Club personnel)
- May be used as a 'smart' device in the Clubhouse to access internet, camera etc.
- Must be on silent at all times.
