JUNIOR ACADEMY

As a Junior Academy member there is a focus on developing the players on course skills. The target for this group is to reduce their handicap to 36.

- Junior Academy Members must have achieved a handicap of 54
- Provision of a Club secure entry card giving discount on food and drinks inside the clubhouse
- Provision of a Club diary
- Use of Club facilities including Clubhouse, changing rooms etc
- Access to the Club Welfare Officer
- Participation in coaching and development schemes as arranged by the Club from time to time
- Tuition from the Club's Professional or PGA trainee 3 x group sessions per year subject to the coaching programme
- 2 x practice sessions per month (May to August) as organised by the Club
- Discounted coaching sessions
- Unlimited access to the practice facilities when under the supervision of the Professional, PGA trainee, an adult member, or a parent
- Child protection and equity as laid out in the Club's policies (England Golf "Children and Young people Safeguarding Policy and Procedures")
- Participation in Junior social events as published in the Club diary/newsletter/mailshots and as arranged from time to time
- To be able to play on the course at designated times under the supervision of the Professional, PGA trainee, or an adult member.

Annual Cost - £75 or £25 if the child or grandchild of an Ellesborough Club member
