**Puttenham Golf Club Bad Weather Policy**

Bad weather conditions present a hazard not only to the enjoyment of a round of golf, but to your physical safety as well. No fool proof system exists to predict precisely when and where severe weather conditions, including lightning, will strike. Therefore, conveying notice to every individual on a golf course cannot be guaranteed.

Consequently, it is up to each individual to be responsible for their own safety whilst on the golf course and to make appropriate decisions including taking suitable cover in bad weather. However, in the presence of an imminent lightning threat play will cease immediately and players must proceed in accordance with Rule 6-8 of the Rules of Golf. Players **MUST** then seek safe shelter either at the halfway hut or by returning to the clubhouse until the threat has passed.

In foggy conditions the course will be closed if the 2nd tee is not visible from the White 1st tee. If fog descends on the course after you have commenced play and you cannot be sure that the way ahead is clear then you should discontinue play in accordance with Rule 6-8 of the Rules of Golf.
