Our aim is to ensure that you and your Guests have a memorable and enjoyable visit and that as the Organiser your day runs as smoothly as possible. To help us achieve this your attention is drawn to the following points and information. As the Society Organiser we would ask you to ensure that all members of your party are informed of the conditions stated below and that respect is shown to our facilities at all times.

DEPOSIT

To secure your booking a non-refundable deposit of £100 is required with the completed booking form.

BUGGIES

Puttenham has buggies and electric or pull trolleys for hire. Buggies may be booked in advance on payment of a non-refundable £5 deposit through the Golf Shop.

NUMBERS ATTENDING

The minimum number for societies is 12. Final numbers should be confirmed at least 7 days prior to your visit. If numbers are reduced with less than 48 hours' notice the full catering cost will still be charged for the previously confirmed number.

CANCELLATION

If the booking is cancelled with less than 7 full days notice a cancellation fee of 50% of the chosen package price x the minimum number of people will be charged. If cancellation is less than 24 hours before, the full package price x the minimum number of people will be charged.

ON THE DAY OF YOUR VISIT

The Clubhouse and Changing Rooms are open from 7.30am and the Bar is open from 10.30am.

PAYMENT

Unless otherwise agreed payment is required on arrival of the visit.

Payment should be made via one BACS transfer, one debit/credit card transaction or paid in full using cash.

PARKING

Would Society members please use the Visitors' car park.

FORMAT OF PLAY

Play at Puttenham Golf Course is predominantly in fourballs. Therefore, please ensure your party also plays in fourballs.

DRESS CODE

On the Golf Course –

Men: You are required to wear recognised formal golf attire in the proper manner. Shirts must be fully tucked in unless designed to be worn outside, shorts must be tailored (tailored shorts with outside pockets are permitted) and worn with predominantly plain sports socks (shoe liners are acceptable). The following are not permitted: Collarless or sleeveless T shirts; shirts cut above waist level; shirts or similar garments displaying slogans; combat or cargo type trousers/ shorts; beach or elasticated shorts; denim; tracksuits; long trousers tucked into socks; trainers.

Ladies: As above except that shirts with sleeves and a collar, shirts with a collar but no sleeves and shirts with no collar but with sleeves are permitted; shorts/skirts/skorts should be tailored and of an appropriate length.

In the Clubhouse –

Smart casual (which can include smart denim not distressed, frayed or torn) is the expected dress code; when dining after golf players are expected to change from their golf clothing; for some special functions more formal attire, e.g., jacket and tie, may be required. The following are not permitted in the main lounge and dining room at any time: golf shoes; hats or caps; tracksuits; shirts or similar garments displaying slogans; beachwear including flip flops; wet weather over- trousers or jackets.

Changing of attire is not permitted in the car park.

Please note we do NOT provide towels in the changing rooms.

MOBILE PHONES

Mobile Phones (which should be on silent at all times) are permitted on the Course and in the Clubhouse for text and GPS usage. However, they are not to be used to receive or make calls.

COURSE RULES

Please adhere to tee reservations. Your co-operation is requested in observing the etiquette of golf with particular reference to Slow play; Repair of pitch marks on greens; Replacement of divots; Removal of marks in bunkers. Please use paths and steps and avoid taking trolleys through the heather, over white lines and apron/green markers or parking them on roads/tracks. Play from Yellow Tees (men) or Red Tees (ladies). The course will be closed in the event of dense fog.

It is a well-known fact that warming up prior to golf improves performance and we have a convenient practice facility close to the 1st tee – ball tokens are available to purchase from the Golf Shop

HEALTH & SAFETY AT PUTTENHAM GOLF CLUB

- Heed all signs on the golf course
- Never play into an area unless you are sure it is safe to do so.
- Special consideration must be given in conditions of poor visibility
- Red flags signify hidden workers in the vicinity
- Wait to be clearly signaled before playing towards people working on the course
- Call "FORE" loud and clear, when hitting a wayward shot
