Tee reservations / Roll up & Green Fee update Autumn / Winter 2024-2025

The following changes will commence from 1st October 2024

Midweek Golf

- The 1st tee will open from 07:30hrs and this will alter to reflect the changes in daylight hours. The 12th tee will be open from 08:00hrs BST and from 09:00hrs GMT.
- The 1st & 12th tee 'alternating rule' as published (see appendix) will be in place. If you are unsure of how to use the rule please speak with the pro shop staff for guidance.
- Member guests green fees must be paid prior to play either with the pro shop or at the bar. No excuses will be acceptable for non-payment. Guest green fee bag tags must be displayed.
- The cost per guest will be £35.00 before 14:00hrs BST or 13:00hrs GMT and £25.00 thereafter to reflect the reduced daylight hours.

Weekend Golf

- Tee time reservations will remain for Saturday play with roll-up on Sundays, unless a competition day. Bookings will continue through the BRS system from 16:00hrs, Monday for Saturday & Tuesday for Sunday. Course opening times will alter to reflect the changes in daylight hours.
- The 12th tee will only be a permitted starting hole when roll-up is in play and no earlier than the published time.
- If there is a 'delayed start' for whatever reason, those tee time reservations will unfortunately be lost. If the delay exceeds 08:30hrs, all of the bookings will be cancelled for that day. When play resumes, the order of play will be a 'roll up' with a two tee start (1st & 12th tees) for the first 1,1/2 hours. After that, only the 1st tee will be open as a starting point with the 'alternating rule' applying (see appendix). If you are unsure of how to use the alternating rule please speak with the pro shop staff for guidance.
- If there is any 'delayed start' on a competition day, the competition will be postponed with a rescheduled date announced in due course.
- Member's guests will now be allowed to start play from 12:00hrs BST or 11:00hrs GMT (non-comp day) and 14:00hrs BST or 13:00hrs GMT (comp day). The cost per guest will be reduced to £40.00 before 14:00hrs BST or 13:00hrs GMT and £30.00 thereafter to reflect the reduced daylight hours.
- Member guests green fees must be paid prior to play either with the pro shop or at the bar. No excuses will be acceptable for non-payment. Guest green fee bag tags must be displayed.

All members should keep themselves up to date with the diary on the ClubV1 app and the daily BRS tee sheet, observing the general tee closures where applicable.

Appendix - Alternating Rule

1st Tee:

A group having commenced their round at the 12th tee may continue their round at the 1st tee as follows:

- With no group waiting to commence their round at the 1st tee, a group may continue their round without delay, or
- Where there is a group waiting to commence their round at the 1st tee, a group may continue their round after the group has teed off.

Where multiple groups have commenced their round from the 12th tee and there are groups waiting at the 1st tee to commence their round, groups will alternate in turn.

12th Tee:

Where play is permitted to commence from the 12th tee the following will apply:

- With no group waiting to play at the 12th tee, or in the hut, or on 11th green a group may commence their round without delay, provided the 12th fairway is clear, or
- Where there is a group at the 12th tee, or in the hut, or on 11th green a group may commence their round after the group has teed off.

Where multiple groups wish to commence their round at the 12th tee and groups are visibly playing the 11th & 10th holes, groups waiting at the 12th tee to commence their round will alternate in turn.

Please note that the 12th tee is open from 8am during BST and 9am during GMT unless otherwise indicated on the noticeboard by the 1st tee.
