


The aim of this document is to review the following issues:

- Health & Safety Risk Assessment Specific for Buggy Use (To include Damage Risk Assessment)
- Disabled Buggy Risk Assessment

# Key Health & Safety Buggy Use Level One – Health & Safety Buggy Use. Do not drive your buggy in this area. This area has steep undulations that are unsafe for buggy use. Level Two – Health & Safety Buggy Use. Please exercise caution when driving a buggy in these areas. Wear & Buggy Use Level One – Wear & Tear Buggy Use. Do not take your buggy in this area. This area will cause significant damage to the course in winter months. Level Two – Wear & Tear Buggy Use. This area is prone to becoming very wet in the winter months. Please be careful when driving your buggy in this area.
