COURSE SAFETY

Players are reminded of the need to shout “FORE!” If you cannot see the full range of any wayward shot onto adjacent fairways



- Players should not play until others in front are out of range.
- If a player plays a ball in a direction where there is a danger of hitting someone, they and their playing partners should immediately shout “FORE!”
- On hearing “FORE!” - Crouch, cover your head with your arms and count to ten.
- Players should ensure that no one is standing close by or in a position to be hit by the club, the ball or any stones, pebbles, twigs or the like when they make a stroke or practice swing.



COURSE BOUNDARY: There are properties and roads along the course boundary. If you strike a ball off the course, you must report this immediately. Please see on course tee signage for details.



GREENS STAFF working on the course have priority at all times. Players are expected to wait for staff to acknowledge them and move out of range, **BEFORE** playing a shot that might endanger them. **DO NOT** assume a greenkeeper will be able to hear or react to a shout of “FORE!”



LIGHTNING: In the event of an electrical storm, suspend play immediately and take appropriate action.



THE COURSE, IT'S STEPS AND SURFACES may be slippery when damp or wet. Golfers must ensure to wear appropriate footwear to meet the prevailing conditions. Wherever possible, keep to footpaths and steps.



BUGGIES: To ensure the safety of all golf course users, buggy drivers are required to comply with the club's buggy policy and follow designated buggy routes at all times.



PUBLIC FOOTPATH: Access roads cross several holes on the golf course. Priority must be given to path users at all times. Players must not play shots until the way ahead is clear.



FIRST AID: Assistance is available in the Clubhouse.
ALL ACCIDENTS MUST BE REPORTED TO THE OFFICE

You are advised to carry a mobile phone to summon assistance in an emergency.

- Ni ddylai chwaraewyr chwarae nes bod eraill o'u blaenau allan o gyrraedd.
- Os yw chwaraewr yn chwarae pêl i gyfeiriad lle mae perygl o daro rhywun; dylai nhw a'u partneriaid chwarae weiddi "FORE!" ar unwaith.
- Wrth glywed "FORE!" - Ewch i'ch cwrcwd, gorchuddiwch eich pen â'ch breichiau a chyfrwch i ddeg.
- Dylai chwaraewyr sicrhau nad oes neb yn sefyll yn agos neu mewn sefyllfa i gael eu taro gan y clwb, y bêl neu unrhyw gerrig, cerrig mân, brigau neu debyg pan fyddant yn gwneud trawiad neu'n ymarfer swing.



FFIN Y CWRS: Mae eiddo a ffyrdd ar hyd ffin y cwrs. Os byddwch yn taro pêl allan o'r cwrs, rhaid i chi roi gwybod am hyn ar unwaith. Gweler yr arwyddion ti ar y cwrs am fanylion.



STAFF Y LLEINIAU: Mae staff y lleiniau sy'n gweithio ar y cwrs yn cael blaenoriaeth bob amser. Mae disgwyl i chwaraewyr aros i staff eu cydnabod a symud allan o'r ffordd, **CYN** y gellir chwarae ergyd a allai eu peryglu. **PEIDIWCH** â thybio y bydd staff y lleiniau yn gallu clywed neu ymateb i weiddi "FORE!"



MELLT: Os bydd storm drydanol, rhaid atal y chwarae ar unwaith a chymryd camau priodol.



Y CWRS, GRISIAU AC ARWYNEBAU: Gallant fod yn llithrig pan yn llaith neu'n wlyb. Rhaid i golffwyr sicrhau eu bod yn gwisgo esgidiau priodol i gwrdd â'r amodau. Lle bynnag y bo modd, cadwch at y llwybrau troed a'r grisiau.



BYGIS: Er mwyn sicrhau diogelwch holl ddefnyddwyr y cwrs golff, mae'n rhaid i yrwyr bygis gydymffurfio â pholisi bygi'r clwb a dilyn llwybrau bygi dynodedig bob amser.



LLWYBR CYHOEDDUS: Mae ffyrdd mynediad yn croesi sawl twll ar y cwrs golff. Rhaid rhoi blaenoriaeth i ddefnyddwyr llwybrau bob amser.

Rhaid i chwaraewyr beidio â chwarae ergydion nes bod y ffordd ymlaen yn glir.
