SOCIETY INFORMATION 2020/2021

AVAILABILITY

In the interest of Burnham Beeches members, the Club limits society reservations to Wednesdays, Thursday afternoons and Fridays. In addition, "Two Tee-Starts" are only available on Wednesdays or Fridays.

NUMBERS

Any visiting party of 12 or more players is classed as a society, receiving a discounted green fee. This is the minimum amount of people you will be charged for. Any visiting party of less than 12 players may book their game of golf through the Professional Shop paying casual green fees.

In order to allow our staff to prepare for your society visit, we ask for society organisers to provide our office staff with a final confirmation of numbers no less than two days prior. This number will be the minimum number you will be charged for.

CATERING

Please contact the office or the caterers if you wish to discuss special arrangements e.g. the provision of "goodie bags" or food/refreshments at our halfway house. **Please note that you may not provide your own food/refreshments and you will be charged if you do so.**

PAYMENT

We ask for our Society organisers to settle their invoices prior to leaving the golf club on the day of their visit. An invoice for the day will be available at the Bar and payment can be made by cheque, debit card or cash. Please note that we do not accept American Express and cheques should be made payable to 'Burnham Beeches Golf Club'.

The £100.00 non-refundable deposit requested at the time of booking will be deducted from your final invoice.

GOLF COURSE

In respect to our members and other users of the golf course, we kindly request our society members to be fully aware of normal course etiquette and complete their rounds in no more than 4 hours. Individual play as four balls is not permitted unless used in a greensomes or foursomes format.

CAR PARKING & SECURITY

Visitor parking is available at the rear of the car park, adjacent to the Pro Shop. For security purposes, please ensure that valuables are not left on show in your vehicle. No responsibility is accepted for loss of property whilst in the Clubhouse or on the course.

A 4-digit code will be supplied to you on the day for entry to the locker rooms and to exit the car park security gates after play.

DRESS CODE

Golf course and practice areas: Appropriate and suitable golf clothing must be worn at all times. This includes tailored shorts with white socks and shirts with a collar and sleeves for men. Shirts should be tucked into trousers or shorts at all times.

Clubhouse: Smart casual clothes may be worn during the day but golf headwear and training shoes are not permitted.

Dining room: Golf wear is permitted providing it is clean and dry. You do not have to change for lunch although a jacket and tie is preferred for 2/3 course dinners.

Golf Shoes: Are not permitted in the lounge or dining room. Players may wear their golf shoes in the lobby outside the men's locker rooms, on the stairs taking you up to the ladies locker room and on the grey rug at the coffee machine in the main lounge when entering through the sliding doors.
