

Meeting held at Hurst Hall:- 18 June 1912 at the kind invitation of Mr Kenworthy.

Present:- Messrs Edward Andrew, Reg Earnshaw, A Hadfield, W Hallam, Dr Hilton, Messrs Kenworthy, Tom Kershaw, Percy Kershaw, Harold Knight, Morris, Parnaby, W Pleasants, Robinson, Slatter, Dr S Spencer, Messrs Reg Wallwork & A Whitehead.

Moved by Mr Parnaby that Mr Kenworthy take the chair, seconded. Carried unanimously.

Mr Kenworthy called on Mr Parnaby to explain the object of the Meeting.

Mr Parnaby stated that it had been suggested that Golf Club be formed and a links made about five minutes' walk from Hurst Cross running towards Mossley Road and Knott Hill Reservoir.

After Mr Parnaby had given a general but lucid outline of the scheme Dr Hilton moved that a Golf Club be formed seconded by Dr Spencer. Carried unanimously.

Dr Hilton proposed that a Provisional Committee be formed to ascertain the cost of wayleaves, tenancies etc. Seconded by Mr Tom Kershaw. Passed unanimously.

Resolved that six gentlemen form the committee.

Resolved that the following gentlemen be the Provisional Committee: Messrs Parnaby, Kenworthy, Morris, Slatter, Tom Kershaw and Dr Hilton.

Mr Parnaby moved that Mr Slatter act as secretary pro tem. Seconded by Mr Hallam. Carried.

Dr Hilton proposed that names be taken of those gentlemen who are willing to join the Club by paying an entrance fee of one guinea at the time of joining. Seconded by Mr Parnaby. Passed.

Resolved that the Provisional Committee report o a subsequent meeting of the same gentlemen who were invited to this meeting.

Resolved that a further meeting be held on the 9th July.

Mr Parnaby moved that Mr Kenworthy be thanked for his hospitality in inviting the gentlemen to meet at his house. Seconded by Dr Hamilton and carried unanimously.
