

## Committee Meeting Friday July 14<sup>th</sup> 1922

Present: Reg Whitworth in the Chair.

Mess<sup>rs</sup> F L Eaton, J H Taylor, A Morris, J Lohead, W C Morris, S W Herbert, H Slatter, W H Andrew and J Gibson.

Minutes of last meeting were read and confirmed.

The following duly nominated and seconded were passed for full membership; M<sup>r</sup> R Radcliffe, M<sup>r</sup> W Haynes, and Miss A Radcliffe.

The following accounts were passed for payment:- T Hindley 1/17/6, J Andrew & Co 3/7/-, Ashton Gas Co 6/13/5, Water Rate 1/7/4. Water for Greens 1/5/1, Maclean & Co 9/6, Hurst Council 6/-, S Travis 3/9/5, Gt Central Railway Co 2/1/8, House Rent £20. Total £40-16-11.

It was decided that the action of the Secretary in having increased the Fire and Burglary Policies to cover the A Hall and M<sup>rs</sup> Woodcocks cups be approved. It was moved and seconded that the third party insurance be increased to £1,000 also that the policy be extended to cover 500 visitors and that an extra premium of 10% be paid to cover members whilst playing on other clubs grounds. It was agreed that the letter from the Royal and Ancient Golf Club Committee respecting contribution for sending a team to America lie on the table,

A letter from M<sup>r</sup> & M<sup>rs</sup> Butcher asking for a testimonial was read; and it was decided to leave same with the sub committee appointed to deal with applications for Caretaker and Professional.

The petition from several members in reference to the "Aitken Cup" replay was read and it was decided that such replay would be thrown open for fresh entries, a fee of 1/- being charged only to those not already entered.

The House Committee reported that that they had met and arranged respecting catering in the event of M<sup>r</sup> & M<sup>rs</sup> Butchers vacating the premises before a new appointment was made. The report was accepted.

The Greens Committee made their report and it was accepted and it was decided that W H Andrew & J H Taylor draw up a notice re trespassers and post same adjoining No 8 fairway.

The Report of the Handicap Committee stating that all handicaps had been dealt with was accepted.

The Report of the Sub Committee Mess<sup>rs</sup> Whitworth, Andrew and Gibson in relation to the drawing up of Advertisement for Caretaker and Professional and the receipt of applications was accepted and approved. It was moved and seconded that Mess<sup>rs</sup> Whitworth, Andrew, Slatter, Herbert and Gibson form a Sub Committee to make selections and interview applicants for the post of Caretaker and professional and submit same to the General Committee for final appointment.

It was decided to invite the Master Printers Golfing Association to make use of the course on the occasion of their Competitions and Mr W H Andrew promised to furnish the name and address of

the Secretary.
