Business Arising.

Shelter: Plan drawn by M^r Jos Gibson was submitted for consideration. Cost £6-10/-> Critiscism that it was too open. Decided to ask Marshalls for quotation for open shelter with 3 radial screens.

Referring to the resignation of the Club D^r Hamilton, it was resolved that he be made an honorary life member of the Club in recognition of his valued services at the initiation of the Club, giving him the privileges of a playing member when visiting the neighbourhood.

As two tons of lime had been delivered at the Club by mistake and the owners had offered it at a reduced rate of 26/- per ton in consequence, it was decided to buy it on those terms.

Rent of Club House: M^r Dearnaley moved that the Committee accept M^r Kenworthy's suggestion that the Club pay a rent of £60 per annum for the Clubhouse. Seconded by M^r Hall. Passed.

A statement of the position of the finances of the Club and a forecast of income and expenditure for the year ending next March was read by the Secretary. Against an income of £771 and expenditure of £716 was estimated without any allowance for depreciation.

It was resolved that during the period of their training, the territorial officers be allowed the privilege of membership of the Club free.
