AUDITORS:

- Proposed Alteration of Rules:—  
Rule No. 2 (c). The ex-captain to be on the Committee for the period occupied by his successor, and for one year subsequently.  
Rule No. 9. Visitors shall be admitted as temporary members of the club. They must be introduced by a member, and the introducing member shall be held responsible for the subscription.  
Visitors before playing on the links must have their names duly entered in the Visitor's Book, and must obtain a ticket from the Secretary or Caretaker.  
Charges: 2s. per day, except Saturdays, Sundays, and

Public Holidays, when the charge is 3s.,

One week: Gentlemen 7s. 6d.; Ladies 5s.

One month: Gentlemen £1, Ladies 15s.

That it shall not be a condition for a visitor to be introduced by or play with a member.

Rule No. 10. No person being resident in Ashton or immediate neighbourhood shall play as a visitor more than three times in any year unless such person is a bona-fide member of a Golf Club.

Rule 20. The Club House and Links shall be open on Sundays from 9 a.m. to 10 p.m. during Summer time, and 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. other months.

Notice of motion that a postal ballot of members be taken that the Club House be opened on Sunday each week, for the sale of refreshments at the bar during hours to be arranged.

Notice of motion for New Rule: That the Club Colours be blue, black and white, and that they be registered as the colours of the Ashton Golf Club.

- Presentation of the Kenworthy Cup and Replica, Aitkin Cup and Memento, Hall Cup and Memento, War Trophy and Memento, Payne Bowl and Memento, Captain's Prize, Runners-up Prizes in the Kenworthy Cup, Aitken Cup, Hall Cup, and War Trophy, also the prizes in the Mixed Special Foursomes Competition, and Men's Four-ball Foursome.
- Any other business.
