

Meeting 1 December 1914

Shelter: M^r Slatter read a letter from Marshalls the builders offering to make a four winged shelter for £8-10/- or a three winged one for £7-15/-. It was decided to leave the matter over until next month and meanwhile enquire the cost of constructing a shelter from old sleepers if they could be obtained.

It was decided to send to the makers one horse cutter and on 14" cutter to be overhauled and repaired.
