THE ANNUAL MEETING of the Members will be held in the CLUB HOUSE on SATURDAY, the 5th MAY, at 8 p.m., to deal with the following business:—

- 1.—Minutes of the last Annual Autumn Meeting.
- 2.—To consider and dispose of the Financial Statement.
- 3.—Secretary's Report.

PROPOSED ALTERATION OF RULES.

RULE 2b.—Three of the nine ordinary members of the Committee to retire annually, but to be eligible for re-election. At the end of the first year the retiring members of the Committee to be decided by ballot. The following year the three retiring members to be decided by ballot among the remaining six. Afterwards the members to retire in rotation.

- 4.—Proposed alteration of the last paragraph of Rule 2b, notice of motion by Mr. Fred Moss: Afterwards the members to retire in rotation, retiring members shall not be eligible for re-election for the ensuing twelve months.

RULE 22.—The Rules of the Club can be altered only at the Annual General Meeting, the Autumn General Meeting, or at a Special General Meeting called for that purpose in terms of Rule 4. Any proposed alteration must be sent in writing to the Secretary in time to permit him to send a copy of such proposed alteration or alterations to each member one week before the meeting.

- 5.—Proposed alteration of Rule 22, notice of motion by Mr. J. C. Payne: The Rules of the Club can be altered only at the Annual General Meeting, the Autumn General Meeting, or at a Special General Meeting, called for that purpose in terms of Rule 4, or by a postal ballot of the members, such ballot to be authorised by the Annual General Meeting, Autumn General Meeting, or Special Meeting. Any proposed alteration must be sent in writing to the Secretary in time to permit him to send a copy of such proposed alteration or alterations to each member one week before the meeting.

RULE 19.—Neither the Club House nor the Links shall be open on Sundays.

- 6.—Notice of motion by Mr. J. C. Payne that a postal vote of the members be taken to PERMIT Sunday Golf, and that Rule 19 be rescinded.

7.—Any other business.
