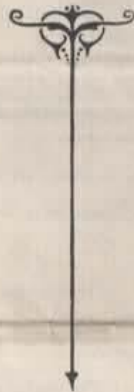

3. To consider the advisability of change in the following rules :—

The Committee recommend that :

Rule 7.—Clause A be amended to read : "The number of Full Members shall be limited to 220."

Rule 10.—Clause B be altered to read : "Visitors may be introduced by a Member at the following charges : First 6 visits 1/-; subsequent visits 2/-."

Rule 23.—Clause A be altered to read : "The number of Lady Members shall be limited to 120."

Local Rule 5.—First Clause be amended to read : A ball lying in manure may be lifted without penalty, and dropped within two club lengths behind the same."
