

**General Committee Monthly Meeting
held on Thursday 21st August 1952**

The Minutes of the last Meeting held on July 17th were read and confirmed.

The Minutes of the House & Greens Committees were approved and adopted.

After discussion it was decided by the Committee That owing to the small amount of Ground at our disposal, the Club is unable to provide an Area for practice purposes; practice on the Course is not permissible on Competition days.
