

General Committee Meeting Thursday May 9th 40.

The Minutes of last Meeting held April 11th were read and adopted.

Miss Nancy Ardern, duly nominated and seconded was passed for membership by ballot.

The transfer of M^r J Marsh from playing to honorary member was agreed upon.

A letter from the Auditors was read regarding numbered receipt book for visitor green fees, also suggesting that the bar stock be taken more frequently, and that goods be charged up to the Steward at selling prices and stock taken accordingly. It was decided to purchase a receipt book as suggested. In regard to the charging of goods at selling prices &c, it was pointed out that this would involve a considerable amount of extra work and the Committee did not see their way to making a change at present, as they were satisfied with the percentage of profit shewn.

The Secretary reported that two new Junior members were playing golf on the Course over one month after being accepted as members without having paid their subscriptions. It was decided the Secretary write pointing out the rules and requesting immediate payment.
