JUNIOR MEMBERS. Junior Playing Members "up to 21 years of age" may be admitted at an annual subscription of half the current subscription.

New Rule on Motion of Mr. E. Raines:

SOCIAL MEMBERS. Non-playing Social Members may be admitted "to a limited number at the discretion of the Committee" at an annual subscription of One Guinea.

The Committee are desirous of obtaining the active interest of the Members in various schemes which are being formulated to raise funds and attract new Members, and particulars of such schemes will be presented to the meeting, and any suggestions which may be helpful will be appreciated.

The Committee have decided to form a Social Committee to deal with all social events, and have appointed the Captain, three Members of the Committee, and a Secretary; and it is desired that these Members shall be appointed from the general body of Members by this meeting.
