Piano:

It was decided to accept the offer of £5-0-0 for the Oak Piano.

Resolved that application be made to the Borough Council before December 1956 for remission of Rates in respect of the Club House and Course, under the provision of Section 8 of the Rating and Valuation (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act
