4.—Proposed Alteration of Rules :—

Rule 3.—The Annual General Meeting of the Club shall be held on the first Saturday in May, or the first Saturday convenient if the Committee decide that date to be unsuitable, and at least one week previous to the meeting a duly audited statement of the Club's affairs and the income and expenditure for the past year shall be printed and forwarded to each Member, and submitted to the Meeting.

(B) A General Meeting of the Club shall be held on the first Saturday in October, when the Office Bearers shall be elected for a period of twelve months from the date of the Meeting. Candidates for office must be nominated on a form which shall be posted in the Club House not later than the last Saturday in August, and taken down during the evening of the third Saturday in September.

No person shall be considered duly nominated unless proposed and seconded.

This meeting to be called the Autumn General Meeting. All Elections shall be by Ballot.

Rule 22.—The Rules of the Club may be altered only at the Annual General Meeting, the Autumn General Meeting, or at a special General Meeting called for that purpose in terms of Rule 4. Any proposed alteration must be sent in writing to the Secretary in time to permit him to send a copy of such proposed alteration or alterations to each member one week before the Meeting.

5.—Presentation of the Kenworthy Cup Replica.

The Programme for the Season is an extensive one, and it is hoped that the Members will do their utmost to make the Competitions a success.

The Committee request that the Members will pay their Subscriptions and Locker Rents as early as possible to the Treasurer.

A good attendance at the Meeting is earnestly desired.
