It was resolved that M^r Lohead negotiate with Agents for the Ransome Triple Horse Mower for the trial of a machine on the course.

It was resolved to empower M^r J H Taylor to buy a reconditioned Horse Reaper immediately at a price of about £12 and on delivery instruct Taylor, the Groundsman to cut the rough between the 14th and 15th ~~greens~~ fairways.

It was moved by J H Taylor, seconded by J C Payne that the application of the groundsman for 5/- per advance in wage be declined. (Carried).

The Report and Minutes of the Handicap Committee were read and approved.

It was decided that the handicap of M^r J H Firth be reduced to 16.
