General Committee Meeting Thursday August 3rd 1933.

The Minutes of last meeting held July 13th were read and adopted.

A vote of thanks was accorded to M^r Rupert Wood for his services in connection with the renewal of the Lease with the Waterworks Committee for which he made no charge.

A letter from Ed. J Burrow & Co was read offering a further supply of revised handbooks and it was decided not to entertain the offer at present.

The Suggestion Book was produced and contained the following suggestion: - That Ladies be debarred from playing on the course on Tuesday evenings and that "men only" be allowed between "5 30 & 7 p.m. during May, June, July and August".

It was agreed that the Committee could not deal with the question and that any such alteration would have to be dealt with by special meeting.

The Minutes of the House, Handicap and Greens Committees were passed as read.

It was reported that the Nomination List for Election of Officers etc. had to be posted on Saturday August 26th and that there are four vacancies on Committee, three for three years and one for one year and that Mess^{rs} F Moss, W H Andrew, E S Jones, and J Taylor were the retiring members.
