

General Committee Meeting Thurs Feb 11th 1932.

Present: G Robson in the Chair.

Mess^{rs} R Bennett, H Ridyard, H L Boardman, P Tildsley, J C Payne, J Kershaw, E S Jones, F Moss, E Raines, R Wood and J Gibson.

The Minutes of last meeting held January 14th were read and passed.

The following resignations were accepted: - Playing Members: M^r W^m Schofield, M^{rs} Schofield and M^r W^m Chappell. Honorary Members: M^r C J Henshaw, and M^{rs} Henshaw.

The following duly nominated and seconded was passed for full membership by ballot. M^{rs} E Lees of Dukinfield.

It was decided that no charge of subscription be made to new members elected between the present date and March 25th, the end of the financial year.

The following accounts were passed for payment: - S Sidebottom Ltd 2/1/3, J Waterhouse & Co 1/8/3, J W Hall Ltd 1/12/-, Joseph Shaw 3/6. Total £5-5-0.

A letter from Mess^{rs} Ed J Burrow & Co Ltd re handbook was read and the advance copy of the handbook was submitted. It was decided to supply each member with a copy of the handbook; same to be accompanied by a circular letter asking them to hand the book on to any friend likely to become a member.

It was also decided that the Committee should meet at an early date to prepare a list of likely people to whom handbooks should be sent and address envelopes and send same out.

It was reported that at an informal meeting of the Committee it had been decided that each member of the Committee sign a guarantee for £20 against the overdraft at Martins Bank Ltd. Considerable discussion took place and finally it was moved by R Bennett, seconded by H L Boardman that the action of the Committee "at such informal meeting" be approved and this was carried unanimously.

The Minutes of the House Committee were passed as read.

The Minutes of the Handicap Committee were passed as read.

The Minutes of the Greens Committee were passed as read.

It was decided that in the case of any person receiving lessons from the professional, a fee of 1/- be charged for each lesson for the use of the Course, but if a round is played, the usual green fee must be paid.
