

Annual General Meeting: Saturday May 6th 1933.

Present: M^r Ja^s Kershaw in the Chair and forty members.

The Minutes of the last Annual Autumn Meeting held Saturday May 7th 1932 were read and adopted.

The Treasurer M^r Robson presented the Balance Sheet and explained same in detail and on the motion of M^r J H Taylor, seconded by M^r J Whitehead same was adopted.

M^r F Moss moved and M^r E S Jones seconded a vote of thanks to the Captain for presiding and this terminated the meeting.
