

### **Meeting of the Greens Committee at Mr Hall's office at 4.30 p.m. on Friday the 10 January 1913**

Present: M<sup>r</sup> Kenworthy in the chair. D<sup>r</sup> Hamilton, Messrs Parnaby, H G Hall, T Dean & H Slatter.

At the request of the Committee Dr Bleasdale was present and gave a short statement of the finances. The expenditure to date was about £200. Mr Parnaby explained what work had been done. The greens were practically all made and the heaviest part of the draining of the course. He estimated that to complete the work intended would require £200 more and it would be necessary to have the sanction of the General Committee for the further expenditure.

It was decided to call a meeting of the General Committee for 4 30 p.m. on Saturday 25 Jan 1913 at Hurst Hall intimating to members that the Greens Committee would meet at 3 o'clock the same day to go over the whole course and would like to have their company.

Dr Bleasdale, proposed M<sup>r</sup> L S Garside as a member of the Club, Seconded.

Resolved that M<sup>r</sup> Garside be accepted as a member on payment of subscription and entrance fee.

M<sup>r</sup> Slatter raised the question of the tenure of the land and asked if it were not possible to obtain from the Trustees of the Earl of Stamford & Warrington an assurance that we should not be disturbed as tenants. Resolved that the Secretary write to the Trustees on the matter.

It was decided to send half of Renouf's fee to him with the request that he defer his visit to the ground until the course should be open and then he would be better able to advise us on the placing of bunkers and general completion of the course.

The Secretary explained that Miss Gilmour had left the town and wished to know if by obtaining a substitute she could have her subscription returned. It was decided that when the Committee had a substitute who would pay the entrance fee, then the subscription of Miss Gilmour might be returned.

M<sup>r</sup> Hall proposed M<sup>rs</sup> Hutton as a member, paying an entrance fee, for the vacancy. Resolved that M<sup>rs</sup> Hutton be accepted as a member.
