

General Committee Meeting Thursday Feb 12th 1931.

Present: G Robson in the Chair.

The Minutes of the last meeting held January 8th were read and passed.

The following accounts were passed for payment: - J Andrew & Co 12/-, J Waterhouse & Co 1/11/1, S Sidebottom Ltd 6/2/11, J W Burton & Son 1/4/3, J W Hall Ltd 6/6/-, Samuel Travis 3/18/11. Total £19-15-2.

The question of a wayleave for steel tower to carry electricity supply "to be fixed in corner adjoining 10th green" was discussed and it was decided to object to same on the grounds that it was too near the green.

The question of arrears of subscription was discussed and it was decided that ~~Mess^{rs}~~ M^r Monk be written to the effect that resignations of M^{rs} Monk and Master D Monk had not been received but that the Committee had agreed to strike their names from membership.

The Committee agreed to accept payment of M^{rs} F Crossley's arrears of subscription in two halves as suggested in M^r Crossley's letter.

The Minutes of the House Committee were read and accepted.

The Minutes of the Handicap Committee were read and accepted, also the Draft Calendar with one or two minor alterations was approved.

The question of Rule 5; "Conditions in the Calendar" was introduced and it was decided to insert the following additional Rule: - In Monthly Medal Competitions, unless there are 10 or more competitors, in each division, only one competition will be held and the division will be merged into one, and one spoon awarded.

The Minutes of the Greens Committee were read and accepted.

In connection with the Dance; M^r Raines stated that one account was in dispute and as soon as this was arranged, the final account would be presented.

It was decided that the Secretary would deal with the downdraught from the roof ventilator.
