### **Meeting of the Greens Committee 16 Sept 1913**

Present: M<sup>r</sup> Kenworthy in the chair.

Decided that the horse mower should be put in order, a new blade to be put in.

Decided to hold a Committee Meeting on the 18<sup>th</sup> inst. At 2.30 p.m. to go round the course and draw up plan of work for the winter.

### **Greens Committee 18<sup>th</sup> Sept 1913**

Present: Messrs Kenworthy, Parnaby, H G Hall, T Dean, H H Knight.

Decided to do the following work during the winter.

#### No 1 New Tee for Winter

Level ledge and put soil over drain.

Temporary green at right of present green.

Cover all greens with sand and fertilizer. Take up all daisies in November.

#### No 2 New tee in front

Put ashes in hedge and cover with soil. Sand in all ~~with~~ the hollows and level

Clean up the ditch in front of green

Temporary green short and to the right.

#### No 3 Tee in front

Put a drain through the ditch

Lime in second hollow

Take of the sharpness on the lump in front and put soil in the hollow.

Take up all the stumps

Temporary green in front

Work out the ridge on the left side of the green.

#### No 4 Tee on left

Sand in hollows and soil covering

Put ashes under the bank on the green

#### No 5 Play off ladies ~~green~~ tee

~~Tee~~ Green on the right

#### No 6 Tee over the 5<sup>th</sup> green

Clear patch by the telegraph pole

Green between the telegraph pole and present green

#### No 7 Tee in front of ridge

Clear the well on 7<sup>th</sup> fairway and put all stones in.

Drain the patch beyond main drain in the middle of the field

Green in front

#### No 8 Tee 20 yards in front

Cut a clean ditch through the pit and open up drains

Hollows to be opened and drained and levelled

Put drain in hollow in front of green and clean up and fill in all holes with ashes

Green to right

#### No 9 Tee in front

Green short of permanent.

#### No 10 Tee over the ditch in front of the present tee.

Lift and drain and level all the deep furrows on the fairway for a width of 50 yards by lifting turf and filling in with sand and replacing turf.

Make a few trial holes for sand on the bank near the 11<sup>th</sup> green

Green to the left.

### **General Committee Meeting 23 Sept 1913**
