Present: E Raines in the Chair and forty one members.

The Meeting was called on a requisition signed by twenty two members to rescind the existing resolution regard the non-engagement of Sunday Caddies.

The Captain opened the meeting stating the position and discussion took place in reference to the wording of the requisition and its exact meaning. The Captain then stated that the voting would be by ballot, and that in the event of the resolution to rescind being carried, the Committee would take it that Sunday Caddies would be employed.

The original resolution standing in the Minute Book was as follows: - Special General Meeting 9th July 1932. M^r J C Payne moved and M^r Vernon Kay seconded that we employ Caddies in Sundays. The voting was by ballot and 21 voted in favour and 32 voted against and the resolution was declared lost.

The ballot then took place and

M^r H T Buckley moved and M^r J C Payne seconded the resolution, that the resolution standing in the Minute Book against the employment of Caddies on Sundays be rescinded.

The ballot then took place and 41 ballot papers were issued and the Captain announced the result as follows: - 31 votes in favour and 10 votes against. The resolution was therefore declared carried.

A vote of thanks to the Captain for presiding terminated the meeing.
