MINUTES OF LAST MEETING:

CORRESPONDENCE:

A letter from Mr. R. Lees was read, which described an incident that took place in the Club, on the evening of the 8th. October, when Mr. R.K. Bell launched an unprovoked verbal attack on R. This outburst was most venomous and insulting in the extreme, but for the intervention of the Captain, this could have had a more serious and unpleasant result.

It was revealed that during the discussion which followed, that yet another Ex Captain, Mr. N. Howard had a somewhat similar experience that evening with Mr. R.K. Bell over a decision he during the final of the Kenworthy Cup.

However N. Howard would not at this stage pursue the matter.

RESOLVED

It was unanimously agreed the Secretary write to R.K. Bell demanding within 14 days, a written apology to the Captain, pointing out that such apology would be posted on the Notice Board. Further that he must tender his apologies to R. Lees either verbally, or in writing by the same date.

It was also unanimously agreed that if Bell failed to comply in the prescribed time, the Secretary was empowered to write and ask for his resignation forthwith and further if necessary implement Rule 19 in the Constitution.

There being no further business, the meeting closed with a vote of thanks to the Captain for presiding.
