Golf Day Etiquette

The management and members of Welwyn Garden City Golf Club expect all guests and visitors to maintain a reasonable standard of dress at all times whilst on the course and in the clubhouse.

DRESS STANDARDS

ON THE COURSE & PRACTICE AREAS

- Golf Shoes must be worn
- Shirts must have collars
- Tailored shorts and trouser only
- All shirts must be tucked in
- No denim or tracksuits
- Golfers must not share clubs or bags
- Mobile phones for emergency use only

CARE OF THE COURSE

- Please repair pitch marks, replace divots and rake bunkers
- To assist the speed of play we encourage players to play a provisional rather than have to walk back to the tee

IN THE CLUBHOUSE

- Minimum dress code is to be smart casual at all times
- Golf shoes are not permitted in the lounge bar
- Collared shirts must be worn, and tucked in, other than tailored shirts with a straight cut
- Hats, visors and trainers are not permitted
- Combat shorts or trousers are not permitted
- Footwear must be worn at all times
- Smart denim is permitted in the bars
- Mobile phones are to be on silent in the Clubhouse
- Flip flops are not permitted in the Clubhouse.

The Society Organiser is responsible for the dress and etiquette of their group. Please ensure that the above guidelines are followed to avoid embarrassment.

Please note we do not provide towels in the locker rooms.

TRAVEL GUIDANCE

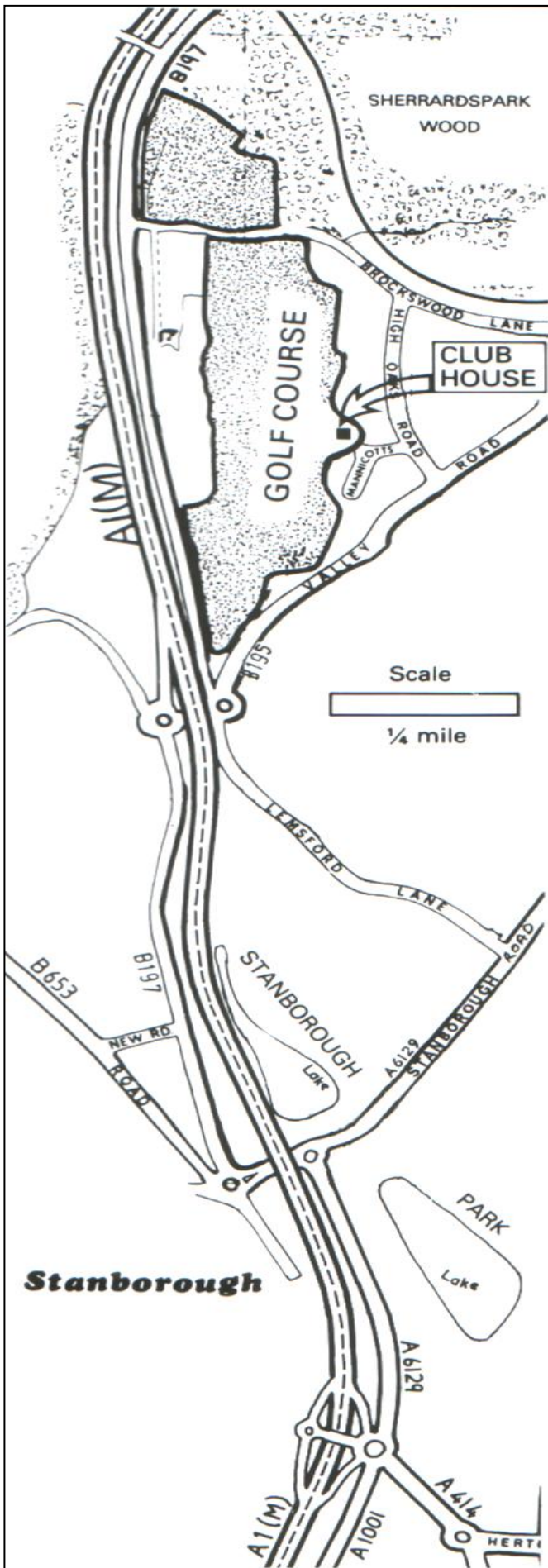
Welwyn Garden City Golf Club is situated alongside the A1(M) west of the town

From the North:

Leave the A1(M) at Junction 6 for Welwyn Garden City (A1000) and Welwyn (A656) then follow the B197 towards Stanborough. Go past the Red Lion pub, and at the roundabout at the bottom of the hill turn left into Valley Road (B195). Take the first left into High Oaks Road then first left into Mannicotts.

From the South:

Follow signs for the town along the A6129, turning left at the roundabout, going under the motorway. At the next roundabout take the fourth exit on to the B197. At the next roundabout take the fourth exit under the bridge. Go straight over the next roundabout (second exit) into Valley Road (B195). Take the first left into High Oaks Road then first left into Mannicotts.





WELWYN GARDEN CITY GOLF CLUB SOCIETIES TERMS AND CONDITIONS



1. **These conditions apply for the booking of any golf day at Welwyn Garden City Golf Club**
2. **Golfing Standard** - It is expected that all visiting groups ensure that all their members play to a competent standard (guideline of maximum handicap for men of 28 and ladies 36). Although we do not expect all players to hold an official handicap, we expect them to play to a reasonable standard in order to enjoy their day, and not spoil the golf for others. Each player must have their own golf clubs and bag, golf footwear and is expected to know, and carry out, the normal etiquette of golf.
3. **Reservations – Provisional and Confirmed** - Reservations will be regarded as provisional until such time as a signed copy of the booking form and the required deposit has been received by the Club. The Club reserves the right to release a provisional booking in the absence of receipt of these items.
4. **Deposits / Payment Terms** - On initial booking of golf day a deposit of £100 is required to secure the booking (£50 for winter package). If not received, the Club reserves the right to take an alternative booking for this day. 2 weeks prior to golf day WGC Golf Club to be informed of minimum numbers expected.
5. 48 Hours before the golf day, final numbers for catering and golf must be advised. **Any reduction after this time will be subject to catering being charged in full.**
Prior to departure on the day, the organiser must pay all charges in full.
6. **Final Golf Requirements** - 14 days prior to the golf day the organiser should provide final information such as arrival times, programme of events including meal times, and special requirements, such as buggies, nearest the pin and longest drive.
7. **Dress Code** - All golf societies must comply with the current dress regulations for the Club. The Club reserves the right to refuse to allow access to the course or clubhouse those who are improperly dressed.
8. **Course Etiquette** - All golfers are requested to observe course etiquette – players must rake all bunkers after use, replace divots and repair pitch marks on the greens. Trolleys and buggies must not be taken onto the aprons to greens or onto tees. Please bring these points to the attention of all of your group.
9. **Slow Play** - We would expect most groups to complete a round in around 4 hours. Anything over this will spoil the enjoyment for your players and those behind them. Please select a format for your day that will ensure that this is achievable.
10. **Liability** – Welwyn Garden City Golf Club cannot accept any liability for any damage, to other persons by visiting players whilst on the Club's property including damage arising out of negligence. All players in your party should be notified that they enter onto the golf course or into the club's premises at their own risk, and consent to the risk of loss, damage or injury howsoever caused. Welwyn Garden City Golf Club can accept no responsibility for the loss of, or damage to property when left in public areas, or cars parked in the car park.
11. **Food and Drink Brought onto the Premises** - No food or drink is to be brought into the Club by clients hiring the Club facilities.
12. This does not include bottles brought in as prizes for golf days that will not be consumed on the premises.
13. **Food Disclaimer**- In accepting these terms, the client acknowledges that Welwyn Garden City Golf Club cannot accept any liability for any food taken off the premises.
14. **Cancellation by Welwyn Garden City Golf Club**
The Club reserves the right to cancel or amend any reservation:
 - If the Club, or any part of it, is closed due to fire, natural disaster, employee dispute, alteration, demolition, decoration or by order of any public authority.
 - If the client becomes insolvent or enters into liquidation or receivership
 - If the client is more than 30 days in arrears with any payment due to the Club
 - If the reservation is found to be potentially detrimental to the reputation of the Club
 - If inclement weather prevents the playing of golf. In this event the club will refund any deposit made in respect of the booking, but will have no further liability to the client.
