- Please ensure you have enough money in your competitions account on a regular basis. You
 can check this via your ClubV1 account. If you do not have enough money in your account,
 you will not be able to sign into the competition.

Competitions Committee. Failure to provide a photo of the card for verification will result in prize money being withheld. The leaderboard is displayed on both the PSI machine and HDID.

Qualifying criteria

The qualifying criteria for all the Honours Board competitions is that unless otherwise stated in the Terms of the Competition*, for PHGC Main Section Honours Board competitions, as a minimum, entrants must have a valid WHS Handicap Index and have returned at least 4 Acceptable Scores (of which at least two must be in qualifying competitions) from rounds played at PHGC within the twelve months prior to the closing date of the competition. *e.g. The Club Championships- 4 rounds in PHGC Main Club qualifying competitions off the white tees within the twelve months prior to the closing date of the competition.

All acceptable scores must be over 18 holes.

Scores submitted for initial handicap allocation do not count towards 'Acceptable Scores'
