2 Competitions

Club Championships (men only)

The Club Championships take place over the weekend of 28th & 29th June.

Entrants must have a valid World Handicap System (WHS) Handicap Index and have played a minimum of 4 rounds in PHGC Main Club qualifying competitions off the white tees within the twelve months prior to the closing date of the competition.

Tailby Trophy (ladies only)

The Tailby Trophy is run concurrently with the Men’s Club Championships over the weekend of the 28th & 29th June.

Entrants must have a valid WHS Handicap Index and have returned a minimum of 4 acceptable scores from rounds played within 12 months prior to the closing date for entry into the competition. The minimum requirement is that 2 of the 4 need to be in competition play at PHGC and can include

Ladies Section Competitions, Seniors, or Club Competitions. All acceptable score rounds must be over 18 holes.

Sunday Medal incorporating the County Medal – Sunday 18th May

The Sunday Medal is open to everyone in PHGC, but the County Medal is for male members of PHGC only,

The male entrants will be automatically entered into the County Medal unless they inform the Competitions Committee that they do not wish to be considered for qualification.

There are two categories:

Category 1: Handicap Index up to 12.4

Category 2: Handicap Index 12.5 to 28.0.

The winner of each category will represent Puckrup at the County Finals on Wednesday 2nd July at The Players Club (Codrington course).

If a finalist moves into a different handicap category after qualifying for the final, he must compete in the same competition category he first qualified in but the current playing handicap on the day of the final will apply.
