Submitting Qualifying General Play Scorecards

One of the major changes introduced with the new World Handicap System (WHS) is the option to submit handicap qualifying scores under General Play. Under WHS you can submit General Play scores to count towards your Handicap Index at any time over a measured course.

All members with an active WHS Handicap Index (HI) can submit General Play scores.

1. In order to submit a General Play score, you must:

- 1.1. Follow the Rules of Golf.
- 1.2. Play with at least one other person.
- 1.3. Play on a course with a current Course Rating and Slope Rating.
- 1.4. Ensure the round is in accordance with Rules of Handicapping.
- 1.5. Play 18 or 9 Holes (1-9 or 10-18).

2. Course Condition:

- 2.1. The course must be in acceptable condition to submit a General Play score.
 - 2.1.1. At least 50% of all bunkers on the course must be in play.
 - 2.1.2. Bunkers must either be in play or declared Ground Under Repair (GUR) by Local Rule.
 - 2.1.3. When a bunker is declared "GUR", it loses its status as a bunker and is now "Through the Green". Relief is available outside the bunker under Rule 25-1b(i) if the player wishes to do so.
- 2.2. General Play scores are acceptable under Winter Rules once all "acceptable score" conditions have been met. Refer to the "Acceptable Score" section of the Local Rules – Slievenamon GC.

2.3. The course condition will be clearly posted to the club noticeboard each day.

3. Before Play:

- 3.1. You MUST register your intent to submit a General Play score before you tee-off.
 - 3.1.1.To register your intent, you must sign into the communal computer terminal in the clubhouse using the "Sign-in to record a General Play Score?" screen. (Similar to how you would sign-in for a competition). Failure to sign in before play will result in your General Play score being rejected.
- 3.2. You MUST pay the required fee for submitting a general play score. This fee has been set at €10.00 (18 hole) & €7.00 (9 hole). (The Committee reserves the right to change the fee amount with one week's notice)
 - 3.2.1. You must pay the fee by using the provided envelope and place it into the collection box. You must write the following details on the envelope: Name, Date, € amount and "General Play Fee".

4. During Play:

- 4.1. As stated above you must follow the rules of golf and play with at least one other person.
- 4.2. The following information must be included on your scorecard:
 - 4.2.1. Date of the round played.
 - 4.2.2. The name of your marker. (Your marker must be a member of an affiliated golf club and hold a current HI.)
 - 4.2.3. Your Handicap Index and Course Handicap (mandatory under Rule 3.3b(4)). NB: make sure you use the correct Course Handicap Table.
 - 4.2.4. The hole-by-hole score must be entered onto the scorecard.
- 4.3. Holes must be played in the order set out by the Handicap Committee. Except when otherwise stated this must be in the usual, sequential order. Any exceptions to this will be posted on the club notice board.
- 4.4. The hole-by-hole score must be entered onto the scorecard.
- 4.5. At the end of your round your score must be verified and certified by the marker.
- 4.6. Ensure you and your marker sign the scorecard.

5. After Play:

- 5.1. Submit you score using the communal computer terminal in the clubhouse. (Similar to submitting a competition score).
- 5.2. Your scorecard must be physically returned by posting it in the collection box.

- 5.3. You must submit your General Play score immediately after completing your round in order for it to count towards your WHS Handicap Index.
 - 5.3.1. Failure to submit your score on the day may result in a penalty score being applied to your Handicap Index record.
