18 Hole Greensomes Gross Stableford Competition - White Tees

(60% of Lower Course Handicap) + (40% of Higher Course Handicap)

The Twist: Captain's Handicap String – rather than shots handicap will be given in the form of string which can be used to move the ball.

- Each pairs handicap will be converted into string − 1 foot for each stroke
- The string can be used on any hole to move the ball up to the length of the string
- Once the string has been used, the length used to move the ball is cut off the string and discarded.
- The following are all examples of what is valid
 - Using string to hole a putt (amount used should be from edge of cup to ball)
 - Moving the ball closer to the hole
 - o Moving the ball in the rough, out of a bad lie or away from a wall
 - o Moving the ball out of a hazard (eg bunker, water hazard or back in bounds)
- If there is a pair that has a handicap of scratch or 'plus' all pairs will be rebased, so the lowest pair gets 1 foot of string

FYI

- > The string can be collected from the starter when you pick up your card.
- Each tee time can also pick up a pair of scissors from the starter. (Please return these when handing in your card)

While string can be used on the 4^{th} , 15^{th} and 16^{th} for the Stableford competition, the original position of the ball counts towards the nearest pin and longest drive prizes.
