HEALTH & SAFETY ADVICE

General Hazards:

- Steep sloping prominent throughout the golf course; take care when descend-ing/ascending slopes.
- Take care when crossing the road that runs through the course, checking both di-rections before crossing.
- Take care when using steps up to and down from tees/greens.
- Under no circumstances should attempts be made to recover balls driven over boundary fences.
- Never swing clubs in close proximity to other players and avoid striking a ball if people are within range.
- Be alert to the danger of misdirected shots towards other holes and shout 'FORE' if you consider there is a risk of striking another player.
- In the event of thunder and lightening it is the players responsibility to leave the course.

Hole 1st/10th. Do not tee off the 1st/10th until the 4th/13th tee, on the left side, is clear.

Hole 2nd/11th. OOB, see boundary hedge on right side, a public road is the other side of the hedge. After leaving the Green, cross the road, beware of traffic.

Hole 3rd/12th. Separate tee positions for 3rd and 12th holes. The direction of play is back across the road.

Hole 4th/13th. Blind tee shot. If players are in front, you must wait for the bell to be rung. Do not forget to ring the Bell when leaving the hole.

Hole 5th/14th. Be mindful of players on the left side playing the 8th/17th hole. The hole has a Blind shot, over the crest, be sure that the group ahead are out of range.

Hole 6th/15th. Blind shot. Wait for group ahead to ring the bell. Do not forget to ring the Bell when leaving the Green.

Hole 7th/16th. Separate tee positions for the 7th and 16th, either side of the 6th Green. Shots must not be played if traffic is using the road. When leaving the 16th tee walk behind the 6th Green. Buggies take the path right of the Green and up the road to the next tee.

Hole 8th/17th. Be mindful of players on the left side, playing the 5th/14th hole. The hole contains a number of Blind shots; make sure the Green is clear. Ring the Bell when leaving the Green.

Hole 9th/18th. 18th Black tee, take care that the road is clear. Longer wayward shots from the tee can bring the 5th tee on the left or the Buggy Park on the right into play. Shout Fore should this happen.
