Drainage work

The past month has given us a very dry period for the time of year which has allowed us to make significant gains with our drainage projects with minimal disruption and damage to the surface.

The drainage work on the 3rd, 8th, 9th, & 17th is progressing on schedule and we have highlighted a few issues underground with broken and blocked pipe work which will be getting bypassed by the new system. The right of the 17th has shown that in places it has no more than 2 inches of soil which will be causing the water to saturate the surface during wet periods.

All fairways have been Verti-drained also.

The firm ground conditions have also given the buggies a greater period of usage on the course than in previous years. However unfortunately some members are not taking note of the restrictions in place and warnings about accessing certain areas.

A buggy went down the steepest slope on the course next to the 6th tee!
