Leadership	Ability to inspire and guide club members,
	committees, and staff effectively.
Communication Skills	Excellent verbal and written communication
	to interact with members, staff, and external
	parties.
Interpersonal Skills	Ability to build strong relationships with
	members and staff, fostering a positive club
	atmosphere.
Organisational Skills	Strong skills in organising events, meetings,
	and club activities efficiently.
Decision-Making	Ability to make informed and timely decisions
	for the benefit of the club and its members.
Problem-Solving Skills	Aptitude for addressing issues and conflicts
	constructively and diplomatically.
Knowledge of Golf	In-depth knowledge of golf rules, etiquette,
	and the sport's culture.
Event Management	Skills in planning and executing club events
	and social gatherings.
Conflict Resolution	Ability to mediate and resolve disputes
	among members efficiently.
Commitment and Dedication	Willingness to invest time and energy into
	club activities and responsibilities.
Integrity and Ethics	Strong sense of ethics and integrity,
	maintaining the club's standards and
	reputation.
Networking Skills	Ability to network with potential sponsors,
	partners, and the broader golf community.
Teamwork	Ability to work collaboratively with the board,
	committees, and club staff.
Collaboration with Board	Skills to effectively work alongside the Board
	of Directors, aligning club goals with strategic
	plans
