## **NOTES FOR VISITING SOCIETIES**

In connection with the visit of your Society, please complete the enclosed forms and return to the Club along with your deposit to secure your booking.

Your attention is drawn to the following conditions that must be strictly observed. In particular Thorpe Hall Golf Club expects the Society Organiser to take responsibility for the conduct of his members and that they are made aware of the Club's requirements.

1. Societies can only be accepted with a minimum number of 12 and a maximum of 36 participants unless specifically negotiated.
2. A non-refundable deposit of £200 is required when booking forms are returned.
3. Provisional booking will be held open for 30 days. The booking will be confirmed only after the deposit and completed paperwork has been received.
4. Any changes to the numbers in the Society must be confirmed 5 days prior to the visit and the number given will be the minimum catered for and charged.
5. Members of the Society, who are also playing members of Thorpe Hall Golf Club, do not pay a green fee, but they cannot introduce Society non-members at the reduced "playing with a member" green fee.
6. Breakfast, lunch and evening meal will all be served in the restaurant when smart casual dress is acceptable.
7. Please refer to the enclosed dress code and ensure that all Society members understand and comply with our requirement on and off the course.
8. On your arrival a member of our team will welcome you and do whatever they can to ensure your day is as perfect as we can make it. We currently have vacancies and, hopefully, your experience might tempt you to consider applying for membership.
9. The Society Organiser should provide the names and handicaps of all players before commencement of play.

We trust in your compliance with the above requirements when we will do all we can to provide your society with an enjoyable day at Thorpe hall.

**The following undertakings are given:**

1. The full cost of the day is paid before play commences.
2. Each player is a member of a Golf Club affiliated to a Golf Union. (Each player must have their C.O.N.G.U. or Society handicap certificate available for inspection if required).
3. The conventions with regard to etiquette, repair of divots etc. made by golfers, slow play and calling-through will be scrupulously observed.
4. The Society Organiser must provide the names and handicaps of all players before start of play. Your society may not be allowed to play if certificates are not available for inspection.
5. **The Society Organiser is responsible for the conduct of his members** both on the course and in the Clubhouse. He is also responsible for ensuring that society members are aware of and observe Thorpe Hall Golf Club requirements and in particular slow play and dress code. (A copy of our dress code is attached)

## Welcomes Correctly Dressed Golfers

Thorpe Hall Golf Club extends a warm welcome to all visitors and we want you to enjoy a memorable golfing experience. To ensure a full measure of enjoyment please read the information below.

### **On the course the following are permitted:**

- Weather-protective clothing specifically designed for golf.
- Accredited golf shirts or roll necks, always tucked in except for ladies when designed for outside wear.
- Accredited golf footwear and trousers, smart chinos but no blue denim or combat trousers.
- Knee-length tailored shorts, not cargo shorts, with knee length socks or any white socks.

### **In the clubhouse the following are permitted:**

- Accredited golf shirts, roll necks or collared shirts.
- Trousers or smart jeans which are not bleached, baggy or cut, knee-length tailored shorts with knee length socks or any white socks.
- Leisure and deck shoes (socks optional)
- Clean spike-less golf shoes are permitted in the Spike Bar only.

### **In the clubhouse the following are not considered acceptable:**

- Rainwear, hats, caps or visors.
- Combat trousers.
- Trainers and men's open-toed footwear.
- Wet or muddy clothing or shoes.

In the dining room smart casual dress, which includes smart jeans, is required after 6 pm and Sunday lunchtime.

The changing of clothing or footwear in the car park is not permitted and members and visitor are asked to use the changing rooms provided. Please use the locker room to change into or out of your golfing attire. The Office, Bar or Professional Shop will give you the code for the day upon arrival.

### **Mobile Phones**

Mobile phones may not be used on the golf course with the exception of a medical emergency. Calls may not be made or received in the clubhouse and phones should be maintained on "silent or vibrate" mode at all times, but may be used in the clubhouse to text. Calls made or taken outside the clubhouse must occur in a suitable area away from the course or the clubhouse with consideration for others.

Members are requested to share the above guidelines with their guests.
