AIRDRIE GOLF CLUB - CODE OF CONDUCT

Airdrie Golf Club prides itself in being a welcoming and inclusive environment where all members, guests and staff can share a positive and enjoyable experience whether they are on the course or in the clubhouse.

In that spirit we would ask everyone to adhere to the simple code of conduct outlined below.

Respect for others

We ask everyone to treat fellow golfers, club staff, and guests with kindness, respect and courtesy and refrain from using offensive language or engaging in disrespectful behaviour.

Airdrie Golf Club adopts a ZERO tolerance policy for aggressive or abusive behaviour towards members, guests and staff. Any incidents of such behaviour will be thoroughly investigated in line with our disciplinary process.

On the course

Familiarise yourself with the rules of golf and play in accordance with them.

Keep up a reasonable pace of play to avoid unnecessary delays. Invite the group behind you to play through if you are holding them up. Refer to the 'Pace of Play' guidelines.

Repair divots, rake bunkers, and fix pitch marks on greens.

Observe any temporary rules or closures for specific areas undergoing maintenance.

Tournament and event etiquette

Comply with the rules and regulations of tournaments and events hosted by the club. Demonstrate good sportsmanship, fairness, and respect towards fellow competitors.

Accept victory and defeat graciously.

Dress code

Wear appropriate golf attire including golf shoes. No denims or football shirts are permitted on the course. If in doubt, please refer to the illustrations on the signage at the entrance to the clubhouse.

Football club colours are also not allowed in the clubhouse.

Use of technology

Mobile phones are now an essential part of everyday life and are increasingly necessary for the recording of scores on the golf course. However, we would ask that phones and other electronic devices are used discreetly and sparingly and please refrain from using devices that may disrupt play or infringe on other's privacy.

We encourage club members to share social media posts on club news and events, but urge comments including negative feedback or criticism that could view the club in a negative light should be withheld and addressed to the committee for comments and action.

Alcohol consumption

Please consume alcoholic beverages responsibly and refrain from excessive drinking that may impair performance or behaviour. Under no circumstances should you drink and drive.

Guests

Follow the club's guidelines for inviting and hosting guests. It is your responsibility to ensure that guests are aware of and adhere to the club's code of conduct.
