General Info/Funding

The Junior Section has seen a steady increase in playing junior members up from last year.

Funding

The Club has generously added more funds to the junior budget and expanded our capability to host more junior events and matches (see 2024 update).

The Junior Section would like to say a massive thank you to those members that have generously donated towards the junior budget. Middlesex Golf also provided a budget for covering Junior Training Sessions. These events were hugely popular, and we encourage as many juniors as possible to attend to be able to secure funding in future.

Matches/Events

During the past year we hosted and attended several inter-club friendlies. Most notable matches were between Bishopsgate School, Fulwell and Ealing Golf Clubs.

We also hosted several Adult Junior Evening events which were run in co-ordination with the Junior Training Sessions. We encourage more Juniors and Adults to join these fun evening events (they typically run from late April to early October).

Competitions

There were several hotly contested competitions this year and a big congratulations to those players who completed and placed in top finishes.

Winners of the Board competitions:

Junior Scotia Cup – Jack Manders 40 Points Junior Hitchcock Medal – Henry Bucys Nett 66 Junior Manor and Walker – Thomas Randal won both Gross and Nett with Gross 81 and nett 72 Jack Manders won the junior order of merit narrowly from Finn Males. This was a new season long competition from results of board and general competitions throughout the season.

The Junior Open was a successful day this year with around 30 Juniors competing in the tournament. For 2024 this will move to May Half Term to try to gain more Juniors playing in the field for a great day of golfing.

Representative Honours

Will Edwards & Jack Manders have both been selected to represent Middlesex Golf County in matches against other counties. Will Edwards has been selected for the U15's side and Jack Manders for the Under 14's side. Both Boys doing their Club and County proud.

Looking ahead to the 2024 season

The Junior Coaching Session plan for 2024 will be to provide a fun and beneficial structure for all Juniors that join the session. The main goals for 2024 will be to keep the level of interest high for Ashford Manor Juniors, try to keep expanding the Junior section & progress the Juniors golfing skills. We have had over 30 Juniors join Ashford Manor Golf Club from taking part in the Junior sessions and hope to keep that number progressing.
