**CONDITIONS / QUALIFICATIONS AND FURTHER INFORMATION:**

- The championship consists of one 18 holes Stableford round played for which a draw will be made. All ties shall be decided on the last 9, 6, 3 or 1 hole.
- Competitors must be aged under 18 years at 00.00hrs on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022.
- Competitors must be a FULL member of one of the following counties – Berkshire, Buckinghamshire, Northamptonshire, Oxfordshire, Warwickshire or Worcestershire & Herefordshire and registered with their County Junior section. Parental consent forms must have been completed.
- The maximum field size is 18 and, if over-subscribed, places will be balloted on handicap index on closing date.
- Competitors must have a WHS handicap and provide their CDH number.
- Handicap limit 36.4 on date of entry
- Girls with a Handicap Index of 18.4 or below who are unable to play 36 holes are encouraged to enter the 18-hole Midlands South Girls' Handicap Championship, which is held on the same day at the same venue.
- Players are not allowed a caddie during the competition.
- Distance measuring devices are permitted
- Buggies may only be used with the express permission of the Committee.
- **No** refunds will be given after the draw has been made.
- Klaxon will be used in the event of adverse weather conditions.
- The committee reserves the right to alter the conditions of play and its decision will be final.
- Parents / Guardians / Supporters / County Officials are **not** permitted to advise their entrant or influence their entrant's game during a round.
- Please ensure that you complete the online entry form and pay via PayPal
- Entry fee includes a light lunch comprising baked potato and choice of filling – please advise dietary requirements on the entry form
- Tee times from 9.30am – players should register 30 mins beforehand
