A 'meet the county' session has been arranged for 4<sup>th</sup> July at Abbey Hill for girls without handicaps or with high handicaps to come along and play a Texas scramble and for their parents to meet our junior county committee and some of the girls who are already involved with county.

# **England Golf**

All the counties have been asked to comment on what should be done with the National Golf Centre at Woodhall Spa, which is a facility which belongs to all the EG members.

We have also been asked by EG to start collecting stories/histories/anecdotes for the EG centenary in 2024. It is the BCLGA centenary in 2023, so we will be looking to start a project to research history of BCLGA.
