SENIORS' SPRING AND AUTUMN MEETINGS

TERMS OF THE COMPETITION

- 1. The competition shall be played according to the general BCLGA "Local Rules, Terms of the Competition and Regulations".
- 2. The competition shall be open to all members of the Buckinghamshire County Ladies Golf Association who are aged 50 years and over on the day of play. The competition must be played at clubs that are affiliated to BCLGA.
- 3. Players must have a WHS Handicap Index.
- 4. The competition shall be played in Teams of 3.
 - Teams where ALL members of the team are aged 65 and over on the day of the competition will be entered into the Vets Cup.
 - Teams where one or more members of the team are aged between 50 and 64 on the day of the competition will be entered into the Seniors Cup.
- 5. The Competition shall be played as a 3-Ball Alliance Competition with the two best Stableford scores on each hole to count.
- 6. The Competition shall be played off handicap. Handicap allowances are calculated according to the WHS handicapping systems as implemented by England Golf.
 - The Course Handicap for each player shall be determined using their Handicap Index on the day of the competition and the Slope rating of the course to be played.
 - Playing Handicap for the competition is 85% of Course Handicap.
- 7. Team members need not be members of the same club.
- 8. All ties shall be decided on the last 9, 6, 3 or last hole. If after countback there is still a tie for first place, the trophy shall be shared.
- 9. The Management of the competition shall be vested in the Seniors Competition Organiser, appointed by the Executive Committee. Any dispute must be put in writing to the Seniors Competition Organiser, who may refer to the Executive Committee for a decision, whose decision shall be final.
